

- **Portfolio:** Portfolios allow students and mentors to create a set of documents that they need to keep over a period of time.
- **Characteristics:** This screen allows everyone who has access to the Student Portrait, including the student, to collaborate on the student's Noteworthy Characteristics, which can be included in the MSPE letter.
- **MSPE:** Provides options for updating the student's Academic History, determining which evaluation questions to include (or exclude) in the MSPE, viewing comparative analysis or MSPE data, and exporting a draft version of the MSPE letter for the student.




